CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I

The name by which the incorporation is to be known in law is
THE MOORESTOWN IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which the Association is formed is public philanthropy for the welfare of the government and citizens of the Moorestown community by raising funds and galvanizing private efforts to: reduce the burden of government by such activities as; underwriting a substantial portion of the Township beautification budget; to erect, and/or maintain monuments or other public works such as the MIA Veterans Memorial; to promote social welfare and lessen neighborhood tensions by such activities as the historical preservation educational classification survey program; to promote education and instruction in the Moorestown heritage; and to promote conditions conducive to a healthy economic climate for all elements of the community.

Where it facilitates accomplishment of the above purpose, the Association is empowered to buy, hold, and improve real estate in said township, and to dispose thereof; and, to do any and all other things which may be necessary and proper.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is to be located in the Township of Moorestown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey.

ARTICLE IV

The number of Trustees shall be eighteen (18), six (6) of whom are to be elected each year as provided in the Bylaws. In order that all groups within the population complex be served, the Board of Trustees shall include representatives of the business, industrial, and civic interests in the Township.

ARTICLE V

Qualifications for membership shall be set forth in the Bylaws.
